The goals of this chess camp are to have fun and prepare students for state and national championship tournaments. Students should have tournament experience and a strong desire to strengthen their growing skills set by seeking a deeper understanding of opening themes, positional ideas, middle game tactics and endgame precision with the key emphases placed on planning and deep calculating. This camp includes detailed instruction on using and training with chess software programs Fritz and Chessmaster to gain a competitive edge.

What are the KnightMare Summer Chess Camps?

A *KnightMare* summer chess camp is a structured week of concentrated chess instruction for beginning, intermediate and advanced scholastic chess players. The goal of our summer chess camps is to have young chess players ready to compete in local, state and national scholastic chess competitions. *However, students need not play in chess tournaments.* Students can study and learn chess for the sheer educational and social benefits.

Chess camp participants are grouped by similar skill and age groups for lessons focusing on various aspects of chess, including chess notation, time management and digital clock settings.
